SUMMER FINANCIAL AID (Continued)

For Duke Students

Duke undergraduates who receive need-based financial aid during the academic year are eligible to apply for financial aid for up to two Duke-In summer study abroad programs and/or summer sessions in Duke offering either one or two courses of credit. This aid is offered in addition to the eight basic academic year semesters of financial aid. Note: this policy does not apply to a summer abroad program taken prior to matriculation or after graduation from Duke.

Financial Aid Advance

Students receiving financial aid for a Duke summer program are eligible for a "Financial Aid Advance" if the amount of aid awarded exceeds the cost of tuition and fees. Students can use this advance to help pay for airfare, visa fees or other important pre-program expenses. Withdrawal from a Duke Summer Program

After cancellation deadline (April 18, 2008) and before program start date

Enrolled financial aid students who withdraw from a program after the cancellation date, but **before** the program has started, will be charged a cancellation fee of \$1,500 for a one-credit Duke summer program or \$2,000 for a two-credit Duke summer program. Financial aid students will not be allowed to use summer aid to pay these charges. These are considered out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the student. In this case, students will retain eligibility for two summer sessions of financial aid.

After a summer program has started

Financial aid students who withdraw from a program after the start date will be held responsible for full payment of the tuition and program fee, in accordance with Duke University's policy. In addition, they will lose eligibility for one summer term allotment of financial aid. Financial aid students may be able to use their summer financial aid to pay for the tuition and program fee. Students should contact their financial aid advisor if they have questions about this.

Eligibility

Eligibility for aid will be determined by the Office of Undergraduate Financial Aid in the same manner as academic year aid using the following information:

Term I Programs

Aid eligibility will be determined based on the current 2007/2008 academic year FAFSA, PROFILE, and tax information. The amount of aid available to a student will be partially dependent on the remaining academic year loan eligibility of that student. Federal regulation requires that all loans offered in the package must be applied for and the required materials signed **before** 6/30/08 or these funds will be forfeited.

Term II Programs

Aid eligibility will be determined based on the next or approaching 2008/2009 academic year FAFSA, PROFILE, and tax information. An **ESTIMATED** financial aid package will be offered to all students who apply prior to the study abroad program deadlines. The final package will be determined once all of the required 2008/2009 financial aid application forms are received in the Undergraduate Financial Aid Office. 2008/2009 materials must be submitted by the beginning of summer term II in order to receive financial aid for Term II study abroad programs. Students should be aware that if there have been significant changes in their profiles, the amount awarded may differ significantly from the estimated package.

Deadlines

The **Financial Aid** application for Duke summer study abroad 2008 must be completed and submitted to the Office of Study Abroad by 5 PM, Wednesday, **February 6, 2008**. Students need not have been accepted into the study abroad program to apply for aid, but they must have applied to the program.

Stephenson Pope Babcock Scholarships

Duke undergraduates receiving financial aid and who are interested in attending any non-language Duke-administered summer program are eligible. Preference will be given to those applying for study in Australia,

Latin America, and the Caribbean. Students receiving the Babcock Scholarship will have the need-based loan portion of their summer aid award replaced by a grant. Seniors graduating in December 2007 or May 2008 are not eligible. The application deadline is also **February 6, 2008**. Applications are available on-line or in the Office of Study Abroad.

For Non-Duke Students

Duke does not offer financial aid to non-Duke students. You are advised to consult with the Financial Aid Office at your home institution.
